Organizational Context and Scope:

The main objective of this consultancy is to develop a context-specific “Mental Health Psychosocial Support (MHPSS)” - handbook and train local-level MHPSS focal points to facilitate cascade trainings for community stakeholders on peer support techniques and referral mechanisms.

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

1. Focus Group Discussion - sessions including the following:
 - Design and plan the methodology for Focus Group Discussion for the “*Psychosocial Support Self-Help Tools for Syrian Refugee Men Living in Germany*” project.
 - Lead and conduct 8 Focus Group Discussions that will take place virtually or at the premises of the IOM Berlin, depending on COVID-19 measures and space availability;
 - Conduct a Focus Groups Discussion with the families of the Syrian refugee men;
2. Analyze the data from focus groups, interviews, discussions, and evaluations, and present the findings.
3. Develop a handbook in line with the objectives of the project in collaboration with IOM Germany MHPSS Unit and design guidelines for the usage of the handbook.
4. Train relevant IOM staff on peer support and basic MHPSS techniques who will facilitate the implementation of a referral mechanism

- Develop set of questions to be asked during the Focus Group Discussions
- Adapt the methodology to 1,5 hours for each Focus Group Discussion

- Write and conceptualize the Draft of the Psychosocial Handbook for Syrian Refugee Men living in Germany

By 31st March 2021

- Review and modify the Draft of the Psychosocial Handbook for Syrian Refugee Men according to the instructions and recommendations of the MHPSS Division of IOM Germany;
- Finalize layout of the handbook, in cooperation with the illustrator

Required Qualifications and Experience

Education

- Master's degree in Psychology, Psychiatry, Sociology, Social Work, Education or a related field from an accredited academic institution with five years of relevant professional experience;

OR

- Bachelor's degree in Psychology, Psychiatry, Sociology, Social Work, Education or a related field from an accredited academic institution with seven years of relevant professional experience.

Experience

- Sound knowledge and demonstrated capacity in conducting assessments, scoping exercises, developing training packages and delivering trainings;
- Experience in community-based psychosocial support programmes in migrants and refugees settings would be a distinctive asset;
- Experience working in the area of MHPSS with UN and/or NGOs, preferred;
- Solid understanding of migration issues in the Syrian diaspora in Germany a distinct advantage.

Languages

Fluency in English and German is required. Knowledge of Arabic is an advantage.
